Proof of Negative Coggins, West Nile Virus and WEFT Immunization are required for all horses.

We rotate paste wormings every 2-3 months. Western/Eastern Flu, Tetanus & West Nile Virus inoculations are administered at the first of each year, a West Nile Booster is given 6 months later. This will be performed and billed automatically to any horse boarded here unless the owner makes his own arrangements. We will attempt to announce regular vet visits or trips to the vet, at which time you may request tube worming, teeth floating, or other vet services, or you may have your vet visit at any time. Be informed that worming, trimming, and some vet bills may be added to your monthly bill. Others may be paid directly by the horse owner to the service provider.

Vet is Dr. Hertel (Kingwood). We haul to A&M or Waller Equine Hospital for specific problems). If you want another vet called in an emergency, please list name and number.
